

Mobilizing Partnerships to Advance a Provincial Intersectoral Network on Trans-affirming Practice to Support Sexual Assault Survivors

Project Update:

Since our initial planning meetings, held across Ontario in summer 2019, the trans-LINK Network has continued to expand and evolve to better meet the needs of service providers and the trans survivors they support. We have worked to hone priority areas for Network development and action through online surveys, webinars, and focus groups. We were recently awarded a Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council (SSHRC) Partnership Development Grant.
